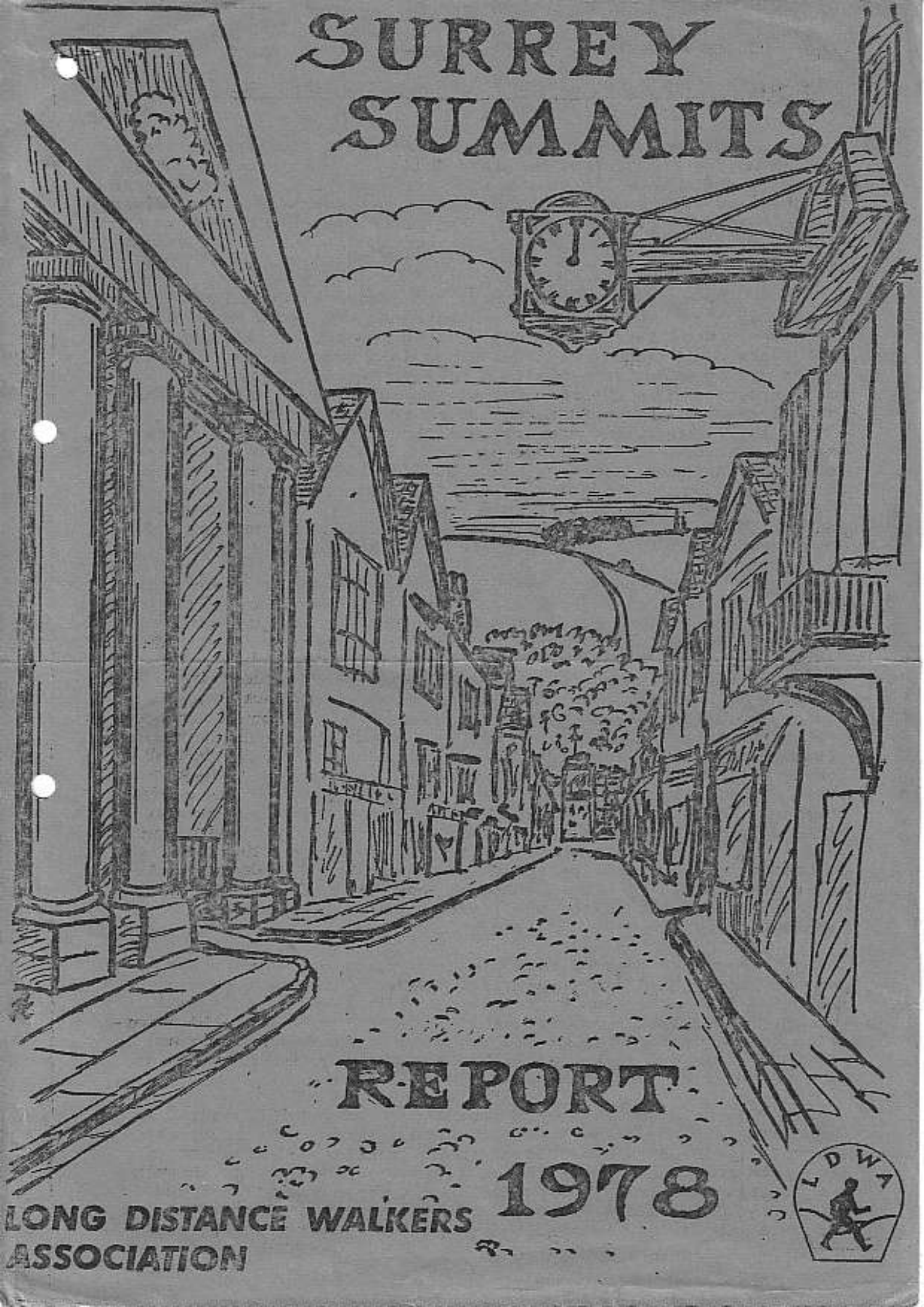

THE THIRD ANNUAL "SURREY SUMMITS" 100 KILOMETRES WALK

Although Surrey may lack mountain and moorland it does have enough open space and moderate hills to provide a hard and challenging walk. Those who knew the area or had taken part in the previous events had a distinct advantage over those who walking in the county for the first time. For the whole of the event the weather was ideal and the brilliant moonlight almost turned night into day.

The walk is fast becoming the southern equivalent of the well known "Fellsman Hike" of Yorkshire and who knows one day we may have to draw lots to see who fill the number of allotted places. This years entry figure was well up on last years and it was pleasing to see so many teams challenging for the two trophies. As was to be expected LDWA members made up the majority of entrants but we were pleased to welcome many newcomers to this length of walk especially the W.R.A.C. and Merrist teams from Guildford. One or two walkers seemed a little ill prepared for a walk of 100 kilometres and there may have to be a minimum qualification for next years entry of having walked at least thirty miles before the event. Of the 141 walkers that set off from Tunsgate in Guildford at 12.00 nearly a hundred finished which at 69% is a good proportion and comensurate with similar long distance walks.

First to complete the circuit was a group of seven hard walkers, most of whom had completed the event last year, and three of which had not so long ago sped down the Peninne Way in just 6½ days. This party included the first lady, Ann Sayer, and the first team. In boating seventeen hours they set a new walking "record" for the Surrey Summits. With the Leith Trophy going to "El Greco" in a time of 16.56 it was well over three hours before the Gibbet Trophy winners arrived. These were the "Steersmen" of the Surrey LDWA Gp. Of the nineteen teams that set out only seven successfully finished although four other teams did complete but their members failed to comply with the rule of keeping together. It was nice to have a visit from the three northern teams taking part but it was a pity that only "West Yorks B" closed in. The final team home was the all-lady team from the W.R.A.C. Unless they take part again next year it may be some time before a female team repeats the feat. In addition to the two legged walkers a couple of quadrapeds also received certificates for walking at least 100 kilometres. These were Ted Brownings "Brandy" who finished seven minutes ahead of Graham Peddies "Dusty".

For next year we hope to have a commemorative badge on sale to those qualified to wear it. Another innovation may be the inclusion of another summit near Elstead thus avoiding Elstead Common. Theoretically an event that is held annually should eventually become perfect but to the organisers improvements are not always obvious and so if walker has any constructive criticism to make we would be pleased hear it.

To make such an event possible often requires almost as many officials and helpers as there are walkers but fortunately several participants conscripted their families and a number of good folk spent many hours in the field checking walkers through and offering them food. On behalf of all those taking part and for my co Organisers Ralph Henley, Jeff Ellingham, and Chris Steer, I thank all who helped to make the third Surrey Summits a success.
