

The 35th Winter Tanners

Sunday 15th January 2012

A challenge walk (or run) of circa 30 or 20 miles on Surrey footpaths and bridleways with MINIMAL support in weather conditions which may be adverse. Only strong walkers or runners should take part.

RULES

This challenge event is open to open to walkers and runners. It is not a race; there are no prizes. To complete the event successfully participants must follow the route description and visit the checkpoints noted. The route is not waymarked.

Minimum age of entrants is 14yrs on the 20mile route, 16yrs on the 30mile route. Entrants aged under 16 years on the day of the event must be accompanied by a named adult (over 18) at all times.

Participants who retire must inform a marshal either directly, or via another participant. THERE ARE NO FACILITIES TO TRANSPORT RETIREES TO THE START/FINISH.

The entry form must be fully completed and signed AND LEGIBLE! If the entrant is under 18 the entry form must be counter-signed by a parent, or guardian.

Entry Fee - LDWA member £3; non-member £5; £5; U18s £1. Closing date for entries Jan 2nd. NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY. Entries subject to an overall event limit of 500

Start time is 7:30am to 9:30am, but fast walkers must start after 8:00am and runners must start after 8:30am.

All participants must have footwear and clothing suitable for a winter cross country event. They should carry maps, LR186/187, or EXP145/146, a compass and a torch if they are starting before 8am &/or likely to finish after 4:30pm.

Booking at the finish will cease at 7pm, those arriving at the finish after this time can phone the number on the route description to record their arrival time.

The COUNTRY CODE must be observed.

INFORMATION

ORGANISER- LDWA Surrey Group.

VENUE -The start/finish is in Leatherhead Municipal car park, GR TQ163566. (no charge on Sundays).

TOUGH EVENT - The venue is an open car park with no facilities (no toilets). There is no food or drink at the Venue and there are only 3 (long)/2 (short) check points with only drinks and biscuits. Participants are advised to carry additional food/drink. PLEASE keep this in mind when selecting your route.

FINAL DETAILS AND ROUTE DESCRIPTION - Will be available for download from Dec 17th or posted if SAE is included. NO acknowledgement of entry will be sent prior to this date.

RESULTS AND CERTIFICATES - Will be sent to all participants who complete their chosen distance.

CANCELLATION - If the event is cancelled, because of factors outside the organiser's control then a refund will be made possibly less an amount for costs already incurred.
