Seventh Annual GUILDFORD BOUNDARY WALK Held on Sunday 21st Sept 1980

REPORT AND LIST OF FINISHERS

The death of the organizer just a few days before the event was due to take place, overshadowed this year's event. This was one of the many walks started by Alan Blatchford and although short by L.D.W.A. standards, Alan looked upon it with special affection, being able to "shoe off" the rural environs of the town in which he lived, thus illustrating that Guildford is not just an urban sprawl. Also he looked upon this walk as being suitable for beginners to be introduced to long distance walking and giving an opportunity for L.D.W.A. members to take their families on an event. The success of these objectives is proved by the number of school children who completed the course this year, although I must admit that the conditions on the day would tend to deter rather than encourage beginners.

In memory of Alan one minutes silence was observed just prior to each of the 10 and 12 o'clock starts. A memorial fund was set up which will probably run to early in 1981 when the committee will decide on a suitable memorial according to the money collected. Alan Founded the Long Distance Walkers Association in 1972 and held the office of secretary from it's inception. He also, quite naturally, had a great influence on the Surrey Group activities. His enthusiasm and dedication to the L.D.W.A will be greatly missed both at national and group levels.

The heavy overnight rain flooded a number of fields on route thus providing the worse conditions underfoot ever known on a walk held in the South East during autumn. I had reports of some being submerged in water up to their necks and taller people being called upon to go in first to test how deep the water was. The weather on the day however, was fine which put most entrants in a good humour as they came to the finish, even if a few harsh words were said out on the course.

There were 251 starters of which 228 completed the course before the "checking in" organization closed down. A 91% success rate is incredible in view of the conditions. The fastest finisher was David Rosen who was also the fastest finisher in 1979. His time was 18 minutes slower reflecting the difference in conditions. Miriam Rosen was the fastest Lady finisher. Oldest and youngest to finish were 75 year old Leslie Griffiths and 6 year old Mathew Cartwright respectively and they finished within 4 minutes of one another. Mathew received a standing ovation as he approached the finishing table which rather confused him and he retracted in a manner suggesting he would rather walk the course again than face his fans

In addition to Mathew, there were quite a few aged 12 or less who finished. Fastest in this category was 11 year old Ben Jones with a very creditable 5 hours 17 minutes - 5 minutes behind his dad.

It is intended to promote the Guildford Boundary Way next year on a Sunday in September. I cannot guarantee that I will be able to arrange the swimming sections.

I would like to thank all those who helped on the checkpoints and at the start and finish point, some at very short notice and some who had intended to walk.
